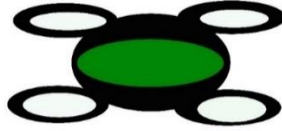

WORLD YOUTH DAY

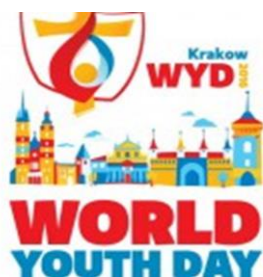
25TH – 31ST JULY
